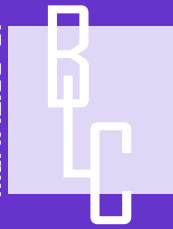

## Houston Update

We have been planning for this trip since we left Detroit in 2015, even though we haven't known which youth and adults would join us, but God did!

There has been a thermometer hanging in the Narthex since October, communicating what our goal is and how close we are getting to reaching that goal. In the past few months, there have been some changes in the team and now that goal has changed. As of now, we have 18 youth and 5 adults attending the NYG this summer which gives us a goal of \$32,000 and we are currently sitting at \$16,500, half way there.
